- The National Pain Council (NPC) was founded in 2020 to ensure proper pain treatment for all individuals both young and old, through research, patient support, and education.
- NPC's goal is to restore patient-centered pain care and end unwarranted targeting of medical professionals.
- NPC is not a political organization, nor offers unsupported opinions.
- NPC's goal for its members and the 10 million other patients in the pain community is to return opioid pain medications previously taken without consent, and to initiate opioid medications for newly diagnosed cases of rare and painful diseases using the <u>Food and</u> <u>Drug Administration's (FDA)</u> approved titration methods.
- Our goals will be met when all patients in the U.S. receive equitable medical treatment, including all patients with painful disorders, by allowing them proper treatment from medical professionals. Medical professionals who are able to do their jobs without fear of sanctions or legal actions by those acting outside traditional medical standards.
- NPC accepts funding from our members and individuals only. We do not accept funds from pharmaceutical manufacturers. NPC is a private Limited Liability Corporation (LLC) registered as a charitable organization in North Carolina.
